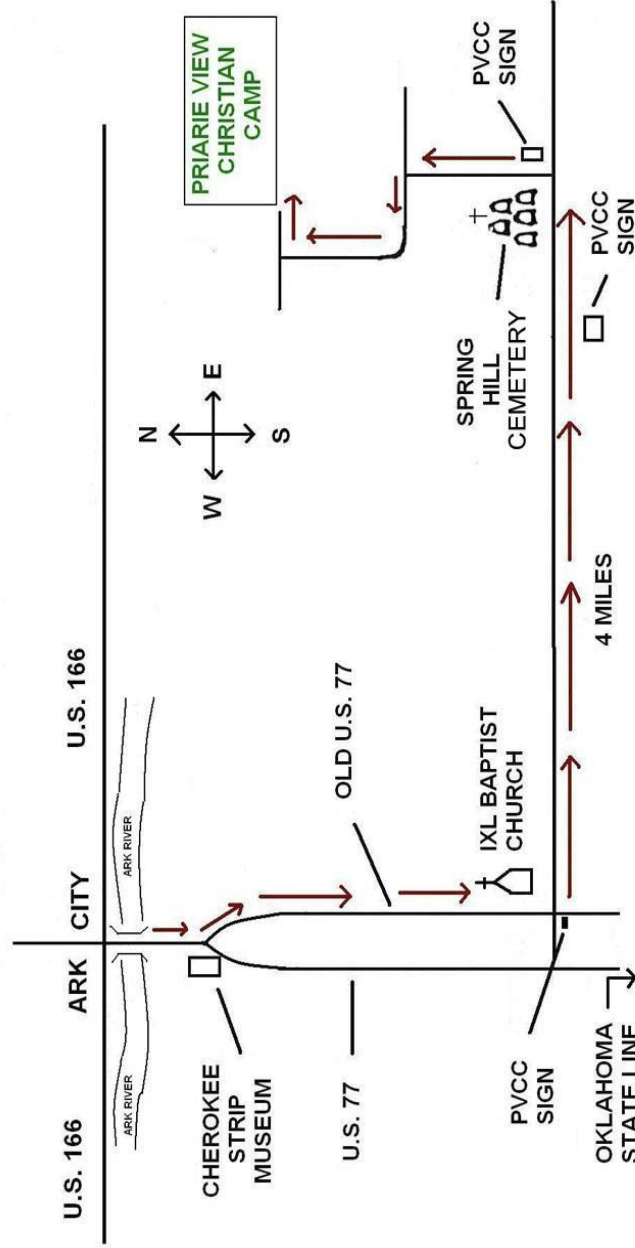


**DIRECTIONS TO
PRAIRIE VIEW CHRISTIAN CAMP
10706 312th Rd., Arkansas City, KS 67005**

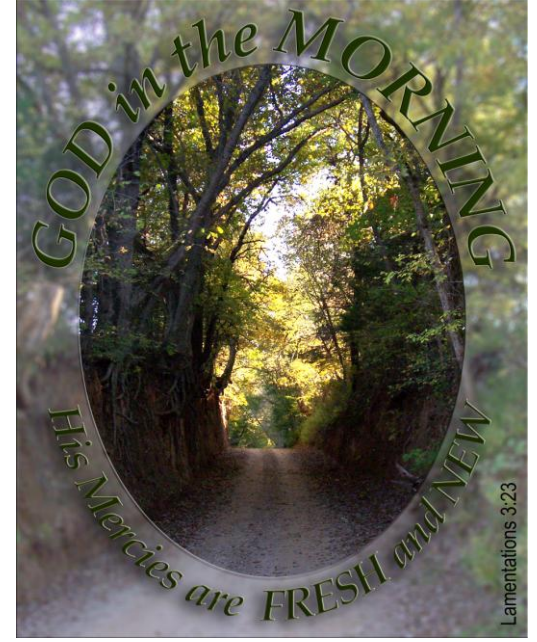
Take the turnpike **south** to Arkansas City (last exit in KS). Turn **left** onto **US 166**. Take that all the way into Arkansas City. Turn **right** (south) onto **US 77**; take that to the Cherokee Strip Museum sign, turn **left** and follow the road to the IXL Baptist Church (sign on your left); turn **left** (east) onto 322nd Rd. Go 4 miles to 107th Rd.; turn **left** (north); (Cemetery will be on your left at the corner.) Go 1 mile; turn **left** when you come to a "T" at 312th Rd. Follow 312th Rd. until you come to another "T"; turn **right** and follow the road into the camp.

(WARNING: There are two very steep hills after the curve...SLOW way down!)
