REGISTRATION & INFORMATION:

1. Please double check that **all** questions are answered on the registration form **and** the activities release form and that the activities release form is signed.
2. Full payment must be received before the cut-off date to avoid paying the late fee.
3. 75% of the registration fee is refundable upon request in the event that a camper is not able to attend.
4. CAMP DATES: High School: 6/1-6, Middle School 1: 6/8-13, Middle School 2: 6/15-20, Junior 1: 6/22-26, Junior 2: 6/29-7/3, Kids 1: 7/7-9, Project Beginnings: 7/12, Kids 2: 7/13-15, 1st Timers: 7/17-18, Horsemanship: 7/20-25.
5. Any lost and found items left at the camp for more than two weeks will be disposed of.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT TIME:

1. High School, Middle School, Junior, Kids, and Horsemanship camps begin at 4 P.M. and end at 10 A.M.
2. 1st Timers Camp begins at 10:00 A.M. and ends at 10:00 A.M.
3. Project Beginnings Camp begins at 10:00 A.M. and ends at 4:00 P.M.

Check with your church for your scheduled times of departure to and return from camp.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP:

Bible, pen or pencil, sleeping bag or other bedding, pillow, towels, soap, toothbrush, other toiletries, two pairs of comfortable shoes (one pair often gets wet), **modest**-casual clothing, **modest** swimwear, a light jacket, flashlight, insect repellent, sunscreen, and money.

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP:

Portable radios/cassette/CD players, video games, comic books, magazines, weapons, pets, food, cell phones, or any other electronic games or equipment.

HOW MUCH MONEY SHOULD I BRING TO CAMP?

1. Offerings for various ministries and missions will be collected at each camp.
2. Canteen items (pop, candy bars, etc.) are \$.50 each. Canteen pre-payment may be purchased for use at Middle School camps, but is required as the only way to purchase canteen items for campers younger than Middle School. The pre-payment may be purchased in any fifty-cent increment desired. A reasonable amount of money to send for canteen is \$1 per full day of camp. The canteen is not used for Project Beginnings.
3. Camp pictures (8 x 10) will be taken each week and sold for \$5.00 each.
4. Extra Camp T-shirts: \$10 each; available in these sizes: Youth S/M/L/XL, Adult S/M/L/XL/XXL/XXXL. The camp theme shirt is given to each camper as part of the registration fee. Camp Hoodies: \$25 each
5. Water bottles or mugs: \$5 each
6. Frisbees: \$1 each

DRESS CODE:

Shirts and shoes are to be worn at **ALL** times, except inside the pool fence. Shirts bearing anti-Christian messages should not be worn at camp (or anywhere else, for that matter). Please encourage campers to dress modestly. No 2-piece swimsuits without a DARK T-shirt over it.

OTHER INFORMATION:

1. Incoming or outgoing phone calls for campers will be permitted only as approved by camp deans. Non-emergency calls are discouraged. Long distance calls are to be made collect or by credit card.
2. Please restrict e-mails to the camp (staff, volunteers, or campers) to important information only.
3. Due to the size of many of our camps, please contact the dean for information about bringing non-camping children with you to stay for the camp.
4. There is a suggested donation of \$2 per meal for all non-campers. There will be a donation can in the dining hall if you would like to donate.
5. All medications **must** be checked in to the nurse as soon as possible upon arrival at the camp. (Please send only prescription medications.)
